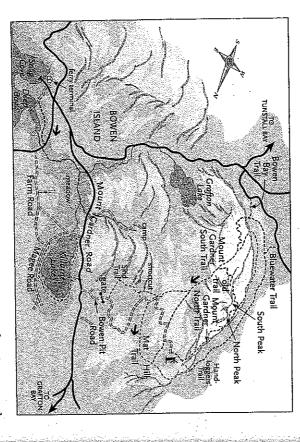

Next ing around the north side of the hill before working west to a junction. around a bend then, leaving the road, go right on Mat Hill Trail, headand keeping right at a junction before rejoining the road. Go upward beyond, a steep trail on the left signed "Alan Garton Memorial Trail." comes a fine viewpoint overlooking the islands of Howe Sound with, just ridge, rising first to a bluff with magnificent views before re-entering the logical debris, the views are spectacular. To return, drop south from forest and continuing to a fork. Take the left branch, which is the steeper left.
