1. (20pts) (a) State the well-posedness criteria for the following 4th order equation

$$\begin{cases} u_{tt} - u_{xxxx} = 0, t > 0, -\infty < x < +\infty, \\ u(x, 0) = \phi(x), u_t(x, 0) = \psi(x) \end{cases}$$

(b) Is the above problem well-posed? Try functions of the type $C(e^{mt} + e^{-mt}) \sin(nx)$.

2. (20pts) For the following PDEs, determine its type and use the change of variable to transform it into one of the three standard form

(a) $u_{xx} + 3u_{xy} - 4u_{yy} = 0$, (b) $u_{xx} - 4u_{xy} + 4u_{yy} - 2u_x + u_y = 0$, (c) $u_{xx} - 2u_{xy} + 2u_{yy} = 0$

- 3.(10pts) Solve the following wave equation:

$$\begin{aligned} u_{tt} - u_{xx} &= 0 \\ u(x, 0) &= \sin x, u_t(x, 0) = e^x \end{aligned}$$

4. (20pts) For the following wave equation:

$$\begin{aligned} u_{tt} - u_{xx} &= 0 \\ u(x, 0) &= 0, u_t(x, 0) = \begin{cases} 1, & 0 < x < 1; \\ 0, & \text{otherwise} \end{cases} \end{aligned}$$

Find $u(x, \frac{1}{2})$, $u(x, 1)$, $u(x, \frac{5}{2})$.

5. (15pts) Find the solution for

$$\begin{cases} u_{tt} + 3u_{tx} - 4u_{xx} = 0, t > 0, -\infty < x < +\infty, \\ u(x, 0) = \sin(x), u_t(x, 0) = 0, -\infty < x < +\infty \end{cases}$$

6. (15pts) Solve the following wave equation

$$\begin{aligned} u_{tt} &= c^2 u_{xx} + e^{2x} \sin(ct) \\ u(x, 0) &= \cos(x), u_t(x, 0) = x + 2 \end{aligned}$$
